**Meaford Energy Limited
Proposed Combined Cycle Gas Turbine (CCGT) power station at Meaford Business
Park, Staffordshire
Statutory consultation under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008
Amendment to Section 42 red line boundary at Canal Bridge 101 (Malkin's Bridge)
and Railway Bridge 104**

Pursuant to section 42 of the Planning Act 2008, Meaford Energy Limited ("MEL") consulted you on 4 June 2014 about its proposals to construct, operate and maintain Meaford Energy Centre, which is a gas fired power station complex consisting of an electricity generation plant and ancillary equipment, an integral gas connection and an integral electricity connection to be located at Meaford Business Park ("MBP"), Staffordshire (the "Project").

We are now writing to you, as a person with an interest in land that may be affected by the Project, to inform you that following statutory consultation and further project refinement, it is necessary for the boundary of the Project to be expanded to cover the entire bridge deck of Canal Bridge 101 (Malkin's Bridge) and Railway Bridge 104. A plan showing this amendment to the redline boundary is enclosed for your information, along with a copy of the original section 42 consultation redline plan. As you will see from the plan, the additional land now incorporated into the redline is extremely small, approximately 125.7 sqm.

As you may recall from the original section 42 consultation, the bridges are included in the redline boundary to enable the proposed gas pipeline to cross the canal and the railway line in order to connect the proposed electricity generation plant with the national grid gas pipeline that is located to the east of the two bridges.

Please note that the description of the Project remains the same as set out in the original section 42 consultation and the content and conclusions of the statutory consultation material, including the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR), remain unchanged.

We are writing to you in order to consult with you on the enclosed change to the redline boundary only. Any representation you made previously regarding the Project is being taken into account by MEL as it finalises its proposed application and will be recorded in a


Consultation Report that MEL will submit with its application.
